

# DASC Executive Board Meeting Minutes

**December 20, 2010**

## Tournament Director's Report

- Last of the advertising money was received.
- One coach still has an outstanding balance for t-shirts. Numerous attempts have been made to recoup the money. Mike F will attempt to contact the team's club to make them aware of the situation. The final solution will be to exclude the team from the tournament in the future.
- Mike F presented a budget with the existing age limits and a budget including U-15 and U16 teams for comparison. Mike F also presented statistics from nearby tournaments to show participation at the older age groups for boys and girls.
- Karen C expressed concern about finding enough teams for the older age brackets for the tournament due to the competition with high school soccer.
- Vote will be taken in January to determine if fees will be raised and U15 and U16 age groups will be included in the 2011 tournament.
- Mike F will be keeping the leftover tournament t-shirts and balls beginning in 2011. These will be sold at future tournaments.

## Spring Season

- Amanda S suggested printing smaller fliers for spring registration. The cost is half of the larger fliers. Parents will be directed to check the website for age bracket information.
- Amanda S will contact John Richardson to have registration information posted on the sign at the square in Dillsburg.
- Eric S presented numerous new suggestions for DASC t-shirts for consideration. Shirts are still available from the 2010 soccer season.
- Amanda S, Lesa K and Tina T will coordinate a fall kick-off/opening ceremony event to launch the fall soccer season.
- Amanda S suggested an appreciation banquet for board members and, perhaps, coaches as well. The objective would be to promote Dillsburg Soccer.
- Amanda S suggested a casino fundraiser as an opportunity to raise money for a DASC player who is battling Leukemia.
- Bill C. obtained information from CPYSL on Silent Weekend for consideration in placing something on the DASC website about this seasonal event.
- Keith M asked if DASC has a policy to handle coach's complaints. Bill C explained that no formal policy exists. However, in the past coaches and parents were invited to voice concerns or present complaints in the beginning of any board meeting. Complaints should be first presented to

the coach's representative. Then, the coach's representative should, if necessary, bring the situation before the board.

- It was suggested that all coach's guidelines should be under the oversight of the board. This ensures that all the coaches are abiding by the DASC by-laws.
- Vote taken:  
The "Dillsburg Soccer: the greatest game on earth" option was selected for t-shirts for the 2011 soccer season. The logo will feature a half soccer ball/half world logo.

### **Fields**

- Curt Bradley prepared plans showing a shed on the new Franklin Fields. These must be presented to the Franklin Township Recreation Board **prior to seeking** approval from the Board of Supervisors.
- Goals were stored for the winter. Most of the nets were removed.
- Bill C attended the Logan Park Authority meeting to present DASC interests. **The Township has indicated they may erect signs** concerning leashing dogs while in the park. A dumpster **may be moved** from the upper portion of the park to the lower area near Hurricane Hall Field. **The placement of advertising signs on the far fence at Hurricane Hall Field and the placement of gates at the current openings were presented along with other possible future improvements. The placement of bleachers at Hurricane Hall Field would present special requirements. The Authority took the advertising signs and gates requests under consideration. They should be addressed at their January meeting.**
