Summer Soccer program was as success. 49 athletes registered online and an additional 29 kids dropped in, some more than once. The club was also able to generate some funds from this program. Jim has some expenditures.

Still doing well with budget. Bottom line is we are still \$290 ahead this year in spite of many changes and expenditures.
